1. Avoiding accidents inside

FIRST

Set a schedule

ake your dog out first thing in the morning, after meals, after playtime, and before bed. Puppies might need breaks every 1-2 hours.

ALWAYS....

Use a crate

Dogs naturally avoid soiling their sleeping area. Use an appropriately sized crate to encourage holding it.

MAKE SURE TO ...

Supervise closely

Keep your dog in sight when indoors. Use baby gates or a leash to manage their space.

KEEP AN EYE ON...

Look for signs

Sniffing, circling, or pacing may mean it's time to go. Act quickly!

NEVER....

Get mad

When your dog goes potty inside they will only hide pee and poop if you scold them. If an accident happens, clean it up immediately with an enzymatic cleaner to remove odors and prevent remarking.





2. Teaching a potty command

FIRST

Pick a word or phrase

I like to use #1 for pee and #2 for poop. This way I can help them know what I am wanting from them.

ALWAYS....

Reward timing

As soon as your dog starts to go, say the command and praise calmly.

MAKE SURE TO ...

Reward generously

Once they finish, give them a treat and lots of praise. This builds a strong association between the command and the action.



Practice Consistently

Repeat this process every time they go, and soon your dog will understand the command.





3. Potty in a specific location

FIRST

Choose a spot

At home, pick a consistent area in your yard for potty breaks.

ALWAYS....

Use the cone

Buying a blue cone is one of the best things you can do! Put this out everytime you go out to potty

MAKE SURE TO ...

Ignore

Potty time is not the time to talk, play or give pets. What you do now is what they will expect is allowed. These things will only add confusion.

PLUS

Travel made easy

By practicing this with the cone you can take the cone anywhere and your dog will associate the cone with going potty.





4. Key Takeaways

1

Celebrate

Celebrate success with treats, praise and attention. What you choose should be something your dog LOVES.

ALWAYS....

stay patient

Staying consistent and patient is how progress forms. This isnt a rece, actually the turtle always wins.

The key is

Monitoring

By watching when your dog drinks water and eats meals you allow yourself to find that timeline when potty is needed. This is a great way to limit accidents.

DO NOT

Punish

I cant express this enough. Your dog will NOT learn that potty inside means getting in trouble, they will hide the pee and poop instead PLUS it will negatively impact your relationship.
